And at the end of it all India have marched through to the finals of the world cup where they will play Sri Lanka in Mumbai. As they look back at the game though, Pakistan would just wonder had they only had themselves to blame. They bowled well but the fielding was all over the place, the catching was all over the place, Sachin Tendulkar was put down no fewer than 4 times who eventually made the most of his chances and made a match winning 85.

But it was that kind of a day for the great man, some great shots but some terrible misses in between. On either side of Tendulkar's efforts there were two valuable knocks played by Virender Sehwag at the start and then Suresh Raina at the end. Dhoni won the toss and elected to bat and for the first 5 overs it seemed that Sehwag had an appointment to make, it seemed that Sehwag had a target in mind, he hit nine boundaries in his 38 and one of the most dramatic moment came early on when he took on Umar Gul, and hit five boundaries in one of Gul's overs. Gul, a fine fast bowler, who had a terrific tournament before this but Sehwag at the start and Raina at the end just took his wayward bowling to the cleaners. And helped India get to 260 where on another day they might have finished on 220- 230.

Pakistan had their moments though but they came with the ball. Hafeez slipped in 10 overs for 34 almost unnoticed. Saeed Ajmal was excellent, Tendulkar just couldn't pick his dussera and Afridi was good too. But their star was a young man called Wahab Riaz. There were talks about Wahab being replaced by Shoaib Akhtar for this big game. But Afridi showed faith in him and boy hasn't he delivered. He reverse swung the ball pretty well at the end and got all the important breakthroughs just whenever Pakistan needed. He finished with 5 wickets and on the basis of this performance you got to say Pakistan did not miss Mohammad Asif, Mohammad Amir or even Shoaib Akhtar, because this young man is a mighty fine bowler.

To be honest at the break 261 on what looked like a good batting wicket; Pakistan would have fancied their chances. But the track had started to slow and it was becoming more and more difficult to bat. Pakistan also don't have a great record chasing in any case. What they needed was a solid start. However they got a decent one with Kamran AKmal and Mohammad Hafeez. Asad Shafiq also looked comfortable and set but realistically speaking their best moment came when Umar Akmal was batting alongside Misbah Ul Haq. Umar batted beautifully but the young man wasn't getting enough support from the senior pro who wasn't turning the strike over. Misbah Ul Haq, when you look at the card you would say well he got a half century, but on his first 30-40 balls he hardly rotated the strike and you got to admit he put a lot of pressure on the rest of the batsmen.



Indias bowling came to the party just when it mattered the most. Munaf Patel was excellent, Ashish Nehra who was a very controversial selection ahead of R Ashwin, justified the faith in him by picking up 2 wickets and giving away just 33 runs in his 10 overs. Zaheer came good as usual and Harbhajan Singh bowled well than most of the time he has bowled in this world cup. However the one thing Dhoni will be very proud of is to get 10 overs from Yuvraj Singh. He has made him a full 10 overs bowler now and that has made the balance of this team quite wonderful. So once again Pakistan came to meet India at a world cup and went away dissopointed as India defeted them by 29 runs and there were some great scenes of joy at the PCA stadium in Mohali as you would imagine.

✍ Use recycled water for gardening.

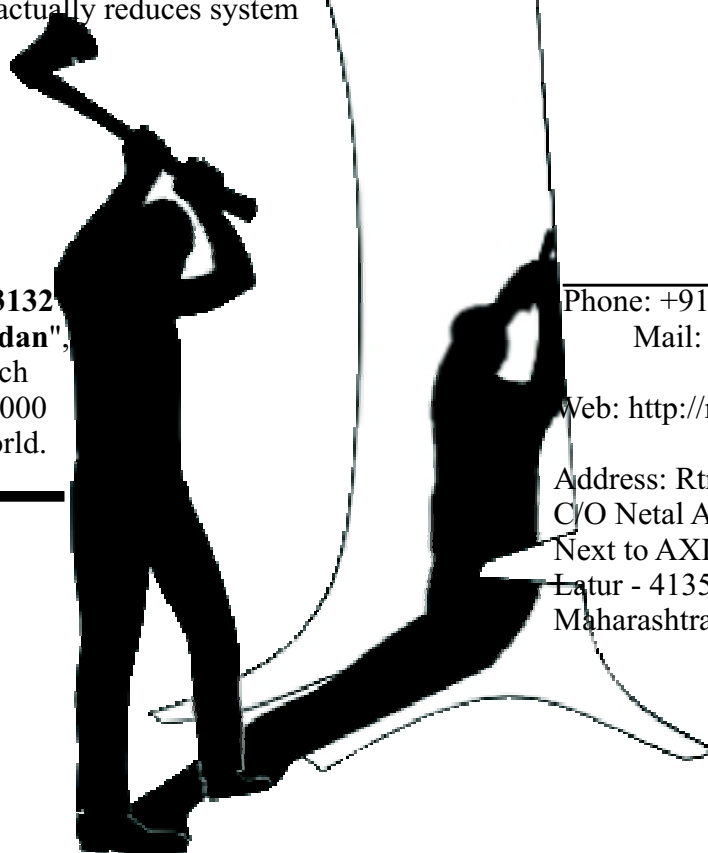
